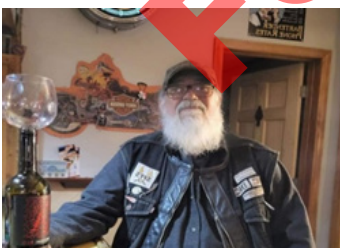
## In closing,

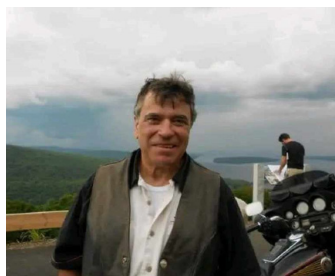

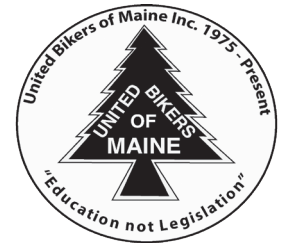

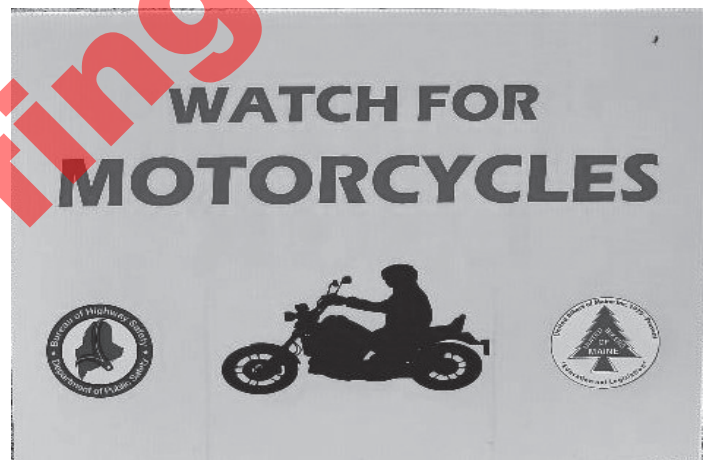
## LEGISLATIVE AFFAIRS AND SAFETY AND EDUCATION



Hello everyone! I hope everyone had a fun summer and put many miles/smiles on. As far as Legislative Affairs goes, it's quiet right now on the state side. However on the national side, we have H.R. 906, the REPAIR ACT. Introduced by Rep. Dunn of Florida. The purpose of the bill is "To ensure consumers have access to data relating to their motor vehicles, critical repair information, and tools, and to provide them choices for the maintenance, service, and repair of their motor vehicles, and for other purposes." This is vital towards anyone with our passion. It allows the small independent shops across Maine and the United States to operate. It allows us as individuals to continue to maintain and customize our bikes. So we are not forced to take our motorcycles to the dealerships. It really comes down to our own motto, Let Those That Ride, Decide. I encourage everyone to reach out to your Representative with your support of H.R. 906. 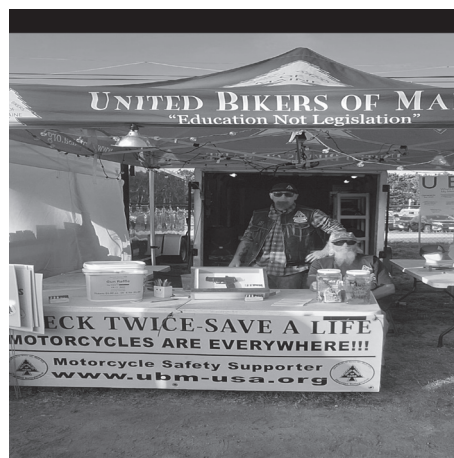


# HANCOCK COUNTY
